**The Bible portrays God as the Mighty Deliverer (Savior) for His people.**

2. In what kind of situations do Christians most struggle to believe that God will deliver them?
3. What are some of God's purposes in bringing His people to desperate situations where they need Him to rescue them?
4. Does the promise of divine deliverance always mean that a Christian will escape their pains and problems in this life?

**Psalm 20:7. Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.**

**Hosea 13:4. "But I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt. You shall acknowledge no God but me, no Savior except me.**

5. The verses above discuss trusting, praising and acknowledging God alone as our Savior or source of deliverance. What people or things might Christians today wrongly trust in or praise for their deliverance, instead of God?

**The Bible portrays God as the Great "I Am", i.e., the Eternal, Incomprehensible, only True God.**

7. In what ways might God reveal Himself as the True and Living God to non-Christians?
8. What are some of the reasons that God repeatedly reminds His own people that He is the True God?
